New Technology for algae harvesting, 8 mill NOK in Grants from the EU

Salsnes Filter in Namsos in progress to develop new technology for algae harvesting, supported by the EU and with excellent partners in a 2-year project, commencing on Nov 1. 2011. Well proven technology and experience for separation of particles from wastewater will be the basis for new applications in the algae business. The market for algae and algae harvesting is huge and growing rapidly.

This is a promising opportunity for the success-company Salsnes Filter to expand their business into new markets. The project involves partners, SMEs, RTDs and Others from 6 European countries: ASIO Czech Republic, Inwatec Poland, Aquateam Norway, UK-HERI Great Britain, Aqualia Spain and IGV Germany. The Operation SWAT project financial forecast is in total of 10 mill NOK, and supported by the EU 7 Framework Program by approximately 8 mill NOK.
